What is the ACCSA?

The Assiniboine Community College Students' Association (ACCSA) is a not-for-profit organization. The Role

The ACCSA is run by a team of elected council members and professional staff who work together to bring services, events and support to the ACC student body. We hold a General Council election to select 12 student representatives to bring forth different perspectives from throughout the college and engage the student body. These council members meet on a bi-weekly basis and work with college representatives on important initiatives that matter to you all

while earning an honorarium and getting real, workplace experience!

The ACCSA is a great opportunity for you to get involved and make some key connections within your college community and the business community as well. Who could ask for a better, more flexible job than getting paid to represent your classmates on initiatives and events that matter to you?!

How to Run for Council

Step 1 Review, complete and submit your Candidate Nomination Package

Step 2 Schedule an interview with the ACCSA Election Chair

Step 3 Begin your campaign upon official candidate approval!

Representatives Must Have:

- Strong communication skills
- Effective problem solving skills
- A team based attitude
- Interest in committee participation
- Initiative, compassion, and adaptability
- Project planning abilities
- Leadership skills

**Elected student representatives must be registered as full time ACC students in Brandon and be in good standing with the College and the ACCSA. All returning students must have a minimum GPA of 2.5.*



General Eligibility

General Council representatives must meet the following requirements:

- Be registered as full time students in Brandon
- Must not have previously served 2 consecutive terms on council
- Must be registered in classes for the duration of the position term (October to April) and intend to remain in the position if elected
- Must abide by both the ACCSA and College Code of Conduct
- Returning students must have a GPA of at least 2.5 to run for council and maintain above 2.0 throughout their term
- Must be in good standing with the ACCSA and the college
- Members may only run for a position for the division in which they are enrolled in as a student

**Other restrictions may apply. Please see ACCSA Election Policy, Section 4.*

Term of Office

October 1, 2017 to April 30, 2018.

Honorarium

As a representative, you will earn \$13.50/ hour and can expect to earn approximately 16-20 hours per month. Your term runs for 7 months throughout the school year from October to the end of April and your hours are flexible based on current events or projects that you are involved with. Honorariums are paid out on a designated schedule either once or twice per year in December and May.
